Borough Mayor and Assembly Qualifications. Candidates must:

- Be a qualified voter of the state of Alaska at a residence within the borough.
- Have resided within the borough for a period of one year preceding filing for office.
- A person shall not occupy or be a candidate for more than one elective seat at a time.
- Meet requirements as set forth in FNSBC Title 5.

Elections for these positions are conducted at large by all qualified voters of the borough.

Terms: The term of the office for borough mayor and assembly is three years or until a successor is elected and qualified. Service is to begin on the first Monday following certification of the election.

A person who has served two full successive terms may not be reelected to that elective office or body until one full year has intervened.

SCHOOL BOARD
(All offices serve at-large)

Seat A – 3-year term

Seat B – 3-year term

School Board Qualifications. Candidates for school board must:

- Be a qualified voter of the state of Alaska, and a municipal voter (30 days before the election) in the school district
- A person shall not occupy or be a candidate for more than one elective seat at a time
- Meet requirements as set forth in FNSBC Title 5.

Elections for these positions are conducted at large by all the qualified voters of the borough.

Terms: The term of the office is three years and until a successor takes office as set forth in AS. 14.12.050.

INTERIOR ALASKA NATURAL GAS UTILITY BOARD (IGU)
(All offices serve at-large)

At-Large Seat A*

Incumbent: Pamela Throop

At-Large Seat B*

Incumbent: Mike Meeks

IGU Board Qualifications. Candidates for IGU board at-large seats must:

- Be a qualified voter of the state of Alaska at a residence within the borough.
- Have resided within the borough for a period of one year preceding filing for office.
- A person shall not occupy or be a candidate for more than one elective seat at a time.
- Meet requirements as set forth in FNSBC Title 5.

Elections for these positions are conducted at large by all qualified voters of the borough.

***Terms.** The term of the office for these seats is 2-years 10-months or until a successor is elected and qualified, per Ordinance No. 2018-08. Service is to begin on January 1, 2019 and end in October 2021 following certification of the 2021 Municipal Election.

A person who has served two full successive terms may not be reelected to that elective office or body until one full year has intervened.

- Completed Public Office Financial Disclosure statement that complies with state law (AS 39.50). Filers must file their POFD forms electronically via MyAlaska (<https://myalaska.state.ak.us/apoc/form/>), then print & sign a copy to file with the clerk. - \$25 non-refundable Filing Fee
- A Municipal Exemption Statement or Candidate Registration within 7 days of filing for candidacy
