

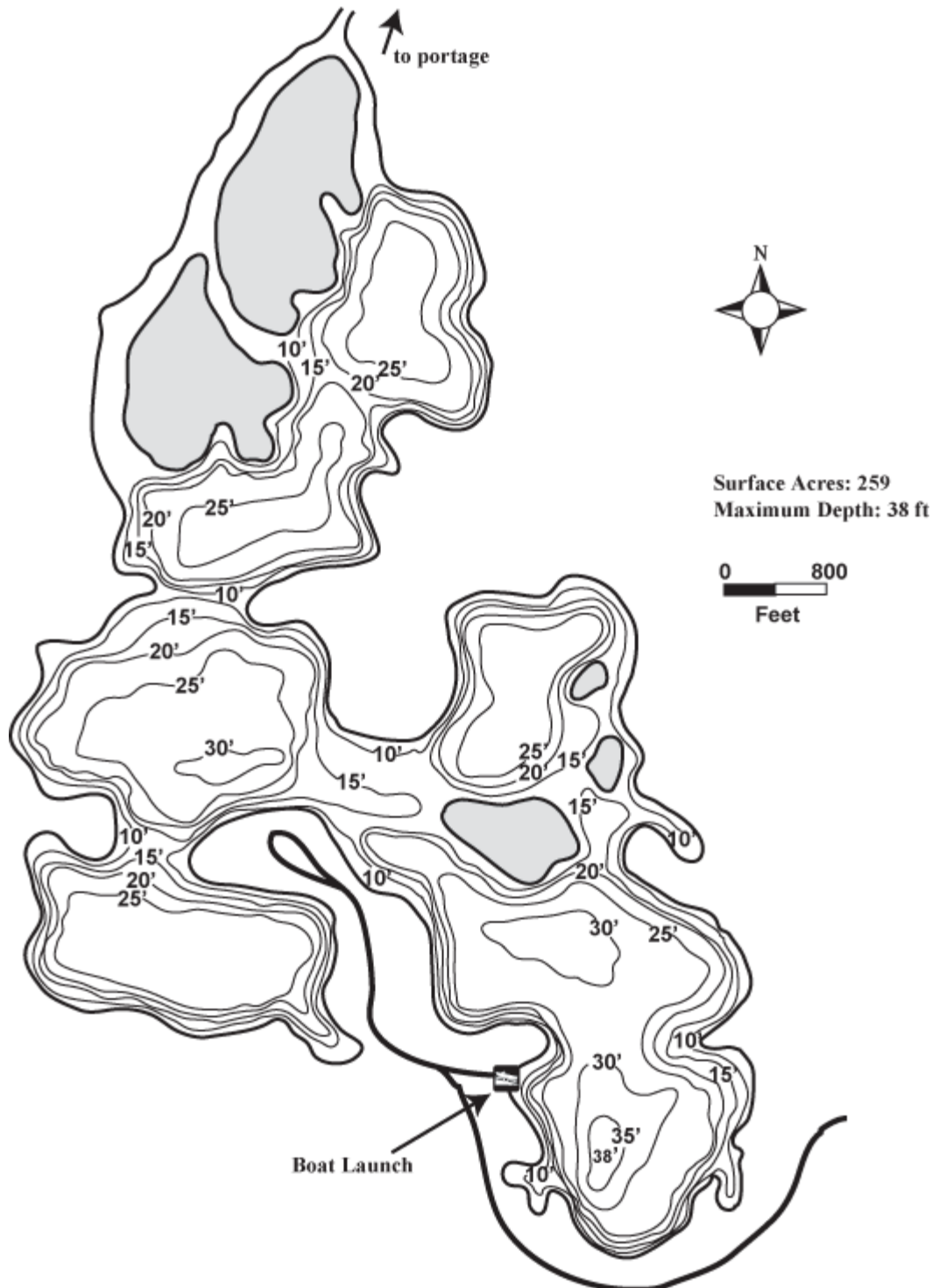


Bathymetric Map and Fishing Information
