

FNSB Air Quality Alert Sign-Up Form

The Fairbanks North Star Borough (FNSB) is enhancing public awareness of air quality issues in part by encouraging its residents to sign up to receive air quality (AQ) alerts. Per Borough Code 21.28.050, between October 1st and March 31st, the FNSB AQ office will issue alerts whenever we are forecast to have poor air quality in the Fairbanks and/or North Pole areas of the Air Quality Control Zone. During a **Stage 1 alert**, burning is **ONLY** permitted in Borough listed solid fuel burning appliances that have a Stage 1 Waiver or No Other Adequate Source of Heat (NOASH) Waiver on file in the Air Quality Office. During a **Stage 2 Alert**, **ALL** burning of wood, coal, or waste oil is prohibited unless there is a NOASH on file. These burn restrictions DO NOT apply during a power failure.

By signing up to receive the alerts, you will be among the first to know when an alert is called and what restrictions are in place.
