

FNSB Air Quality Alert Burn Restrictions for Solid Fuel Burning Appliances Stage 1 Waiver



(Revised 8-16-17)

Properties located in the Air Quality Control Zone (AQCZ) of the Fairbanks North Star Borough (FNSB) (see map on page 3 – or call the Air Quality office if you are unsure whether or not you are in the area) are subject to restrictions on the use of solid fuel burning appliances (SFBA) and waste oil burning appliances during air alerts as per FNSB Code 21.28.050. During a Stage 1 air alert, residents may not add fuel to the combustion chamber or firebox of any SFBA or waste oil burning appliance. Building owners or other persons with a property or managerial interest in the building who receive a Stage 1 waiver are exempt from Stage 1 air alert restrictions for that building. A resident with a Borough listed SFBA (e.g. EPA certified wood and pellet stoves with an emissions rating of 2.5 g/hr or less, EPA certified hydronic heaters with an emissions rating of 0.10 lbs/million btu or less, masonry heaters, cook stoves, and fireplaces) may apply for a Stage 1 waiver and, if the waiver is granted, continue to use their appliance(s). **This waiver does NOT allow continued use of the appliance(s) during a Stage 2 alert.**
